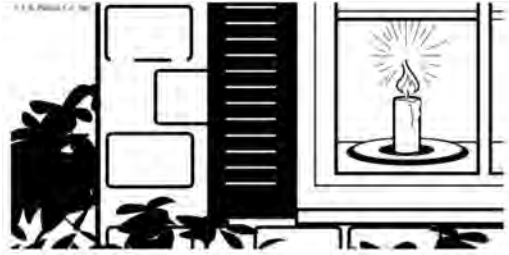
CHURCH ETIQUETTE

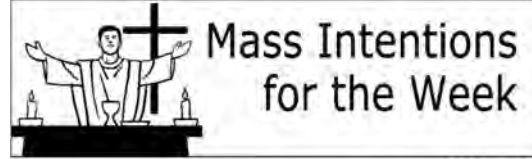

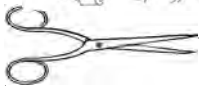
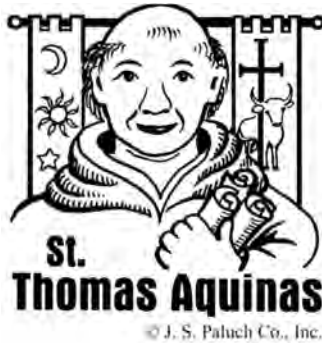
