The Parish Office will be closed Good Friday, April 14 and Easter Monday, April 17

On **Holy Thursday** the only Masses permitted are the Chrism Mass and the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper. According to an ancient tradition, all Masses without an assembly are forbidden. The local bishop may permit another Mass of the Lord's Supper to be celebrated in the evening. In the case of genuine necessity, Mass may be permitted by the bishop in the morning, but exclusively for those unable to participate in the evening Mass. Such morning Masses must not be celebrated for the advantage of private persons or in any way prejudice the principal evening Mass.

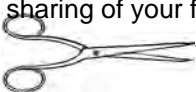
Deacon José and his wife Margarita have been married for 35 years and, as he would say, they have been dating for 38 years. They have three children and two grandchildren.
