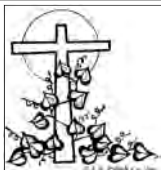

THE 13TH DAY

In a world torn apart by persecution, war, and oppression, three children in Fatima, Portugal, were chosen by God to offer an urgent message of hope to the world. Based on the memoirs of the oldest seer, Lucia Santos, and many thousands of independent eye-witness accounts, *The 13th Day* dramatizes the true story of three young shepherds who experienced six apparitions of Our Lady between May and October 1917, which culminated in the final prophesied Miracle of the Sun on October 13. Abducted from their homes, thrown into prison, and interrogated under the threat of death in the government's attempt to silence them, the children remained true to their story about the crucial messages from Mary of prayer, repentance, and conversion for the world.

Our Lady gave a secret to the children told in three parts, from a harrowing vision of hell, to prophetic warnings of future events including the advent and timing of the Second World War, the spread of Communism, and the attempted assassination of the Pope.

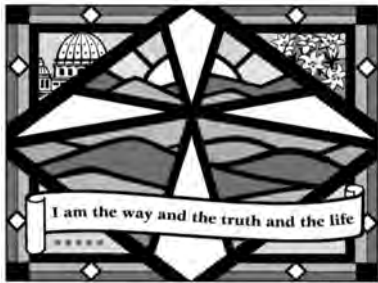

En un mundo destrozado por persecución, guerra y opresión, tres niños en Fátima, Portugal, fueron elegidos por Dios para ofrecer al mundo un mensaje urgente de esperanza. Basada en las memorias de la vidente mayor, Lucía Santos, y miles de testimonios de testigos independientes, la película *El Día 13* lleva a cabo una dramatización de la verdadera historia de los tres pastores, quienes reciben seis apariciones de Nuestra Señora entre mayo y octubre de 1917, que culminaron con el ya antes profetizado Milagro del Sol, el 13 de octubre. Aunque fueron secuestrados de sus hogares, llevados a la prisión e interrogados bajo la amenaza de muerte en el intento del gobierno de silenciarlos, los niños permanecieron firmes en su historia acerca de los mensajes cruciales de María con respecto a la oración, al arrepentimiento y a la conversión del mundo.

Nuestra Señora le dio un secreto a los niños, que fue dado en tres partes, que comprende desde una visión horribla del infierno, hasta las advertencias proféticas de eventos futuros que incluían la Segunda Guerra Mundial, la propagación del Comunismo y el intento de asesinato del Papa.
