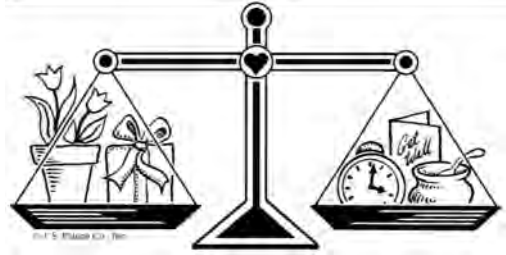
CHURCH ETIQUETTE

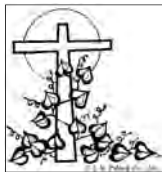
