CHURCH ETIQUETTE

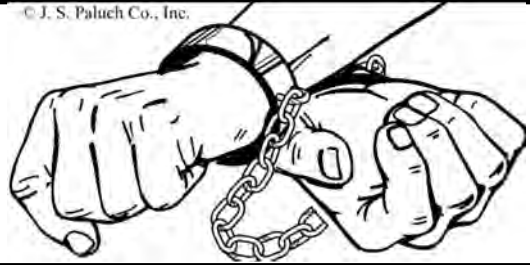
1. Please turn off or silence all cell phones and pagers.

Monday, September 11, 2017 AND Monday, September 18, 2017

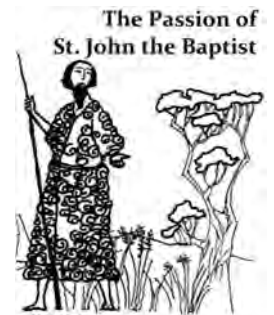
