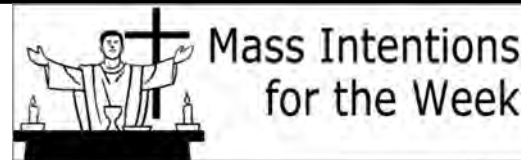

Catholic Charities Immigration Legal Services Program will be providing *FREE* DACA RENEWALS. Service will include a FREE DACA legal consult and legal representation at filing by our Department of Justice Accredited Representatives.

The DACA program was brought to a halt on September 5, 2017. No NEW/INITIAL Applications will accepted. Now, only certain DACA recipients can renew their work permits ONLY UNTIL October 5th 2017. After this date US Citizenship and Immigration Services will no longer be accepting renewals. We strongly recommend that all DACA recipients whose work permits expire by March 5th 2018 renew their work permits AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

We will prioritize DACA renewal cases. Daily Walk-ins are welcome OR you may call to make appointment Mon-Fri at (209) 444-5910 or email aflores@ccstockton.org DEADLINE TO RENEW: OCTOBER 5TH 2017. DEADLINE TO MAIL OUT: OCTOBER 3RD 2017.
